The NHA manages 234 units of State Family, 560 units of Federal Family; 293 Federal Elderly; 700 units of HCV; 273 Housing Tax Credit units and 153 units are under the RAD program. There are 215 students in the After School and summer programs and 48 scholarship recipients (\$193,750.00 awarded in 2017). A strong FSS program exists.
