Childhood experts agree: Attending a high-quality preschool program prepares kids for kindergarten and beyond. At preschool not only do children become exposed to numbers, letters and shapes, but even more importantly, they learn how to get along with other children and share and contribute in the classroom.

Finding the best option for your child takes time.

- Call each preschool you are considering and ask about its fees, admission policy and what they teach.
- Visit the preschools that you think will best meet your needs and spend time in a classroom to observe.

What To Consider When Choosing a **Preschool for Your Child**

- Is it close to home or work?
- Do you need half-day or a full day? Do you need 2-3 days a week or full time?
- Is the preschool clean and safe?
- Is there an outdoor play area?
- Are there different activity areas in the classroom?
- Are there lots of materials and books?
- Is there student work on the walls?
- What early childhood credentials do the staff have?
- Is the atmosphere friendly and fun?
- Are parents welcome to visit and observe their child?
